

Web Filtering and Reporting Suite 5.1.20 Release Notes

Trustwave is pleased to announce the release of Web Filtering and Reporting Suite (WFR) software version 5.1.20. This software release requires a Trustwave WFR appliance running software version 5.1.10 and will upgrade the Trustwave WFR software version to 5.1.20. This release is not available to any 32-bit appliances.

Web Filter New Features

Web Filter 5.1.20 includes the following significant feature updates:

Bridge Mode certificate updating

Bridge Mode certificates created on a source server are automatically synchronized to target servers.

Mobile Security Client version

This release includes MSC version 2.1.4. This version of MSC works with Internet Explorer 11 and Mac OS 10.9 (Mavericks).

Security Reporter

WFR 5.1.20 includes Security Reporter 3.3.15. This is the same version of SR included in the most recent release of WFR 5.1.10. For a list of resolved issues in this version of SR, see below.
